

Scripture Reading Romans 8:31- 39 (NIV) (p. 1152)

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? It is God who justifies. Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to
