Stephen Ministers are lay persons who have completed 50 hours of training to learn how to come alongside someone experiencing a difficult time such as divorce, grief, hospitalization, unemployment, terminal illness, relocation, chronic illness, or loneliness. Stephen Ministers meet with their care receiver at least once a week for pastoral care. All conversations are entirely confidential. Stephen Ministers are also available after services to pray or talk with people who have concerns. Men are matched with male Stephen Ministers and women are matched with female Stephen Ministers. ## MISSION OF THE MONTH

☞ *September & October: Sleep in Heavenly Peace*  
 Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHP) is THE ONLY charity providing hand-made bunk beds to children who don't have beds of their own. Our local chapter of Sleep in Heavenly Peace is a growing group of volunteers dedicated to building, assembling and delivering beds to children (ages 3-17) in need in the greater Syracuse and Oswego City area. SHP is locally all volunteer. Since the first delivery on October 6, 2018, SHP has delivered over 5170 beds and counting.

DCC has scheduled a bed build at the SHP Shop on 519 Brown Ave., Syracuse, NY 13208, on **Saturday, October 26, 10 AM -1 PM**. We will build 20 beds. If you plan to assist with the bed build, you MUST complete the form at the link below.
